Q: What is a MAP Center Learning Network Cohort (LNC)?

A: A LNC is an intentional learning community that provides shared learning and networking opportunities for Center partners related to a common topic of interest or shared goals.

Q: What services does a MAP Center partner receive as a member of a LNC?

A: LNC members receive invitations to participate in two online learning experiences and one online discussion forum or virtual round table.

LNC members have access to a password-protected E-forum with downloadable resources, articles and equity tools.

Q. What are the goals for the Culturally Responsive/Asset-based Learning Network Cohort?

A: 1) One goal of the Culturally Responsive/Asset-based Learning Network Cohort is to support your equity efforts towards implementing culturally responsive/asset-based instructional practices through the provision of shared learning and networking opportunities.

2) The second goal is to advance your repertoire of resources and tools to facilitate capacity building related to implementing culturally responsive/asset-based instructional practices through the provision of research and practice-based resources and tools.
